

VATUSA Denver ARTCC and VATUSA Jacksonville ARTCC

LETTER OF AGREEMENT

EFFECTIVE: January 23, 2019

SUBJECT: INTERFACILITY VISITING PRIVILEGES

PURPOSE: This agreement between Denver ARTCC (vZDV) and Jacksonville ARTCC (vZJX) covers procedures for interfacility automatic visitation for minor positions.

PROCEDURES:

- A. All active vZDV controllers holding a controller rating of S1 or greater, who are certified to control vZDV minor positions, shall be granted the same privileges at vZJX as visiting controllers. No request will be required by the controller, as these privileges will be automatic and immediate.
- B. All active vZJX controllers holding a controller rating of S1 or greater, who are certified to control vZJX minor positions, shall be granted the same privileges at vZDV as visiting controllers. No request will be required by the controller, as these privileges will be automatic and immediate.
- C. Automatic visiting privileges shall only extend to minor facilities. Designated airspace, as defined in the VATSIM Global Ratings Policy, shall not be included in this arrangement. Controllers shall obtain major airspace certifications the same as any visiting controller
- D. This arrangement may be terminated for specific controllers with cause by the Air Traffic Manager or Deputy Air Traffic Manager of the visited ARTCC. The staff member initiating the termination of privileges shall notify the member's Air Traffic Manager and Deputy Air Traffic Manager of the termination. The management of the home facility shall notify the member of their termination from the program.
- E. This arrangement remains subject to the terms of the VATUSA General Policy (DP001).
- F. Controllers exercising automatic visiting privileges are not subject to any minimum visiting controller activity requirements of the visited facility.
- G. Automatic visitation is suspended for all users 6 calendar months after the effective date.
